Position: **Counselor**

Responsible to: Program Director, Administrator

Time Required: Summer Staff orientation June 2-8, 2017; Summer camp and Summer Staff Dis-orientation;
July 14-16, 2017.

Purpose:

- ◆ To be a witness and role model of Jesus Christ to campers, especially campers in their cabins.
- ◆ To provide care for campers and give leadership including building relationships and community in the cabin setting.

Qualifications:

- ◆ Personal commitment to Jesus Christ and to living out Christian faith.
- ◆ Enjoy working with children and spending time outdoors.
- ◆ Able to serve as a positive Christian role model, be responsible, and open to instruction.
- ◆ Relates well with others - staff and campers.
- ◆ Will uphold Anabaptist beliefs, even if coming from another faith background.
- ◆ At least 18 years old.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- ◆ Read all materials sent before camp.
- ◆ Attend staff orientation.
- ◆ Interact and build relationships with campers.
- ◆ Be a positive role model to campers and other staff.
- ◆ Lead devotional, sharing and prayer times with campers each day.
- ◆ Willing to verbally share your personal faith, including at campfire if asked by Camp Pastor or Program Director ahead of time.
- ◆ Walk in prayer and continue personal spiritual development.
- ◆ Assist in maintaining an environment that is presentable and welcoming.
- ◆ Model and support all camp policies and guidelines.
- ◆ Participate with campers in all programmed activities and assigned daily tasks
- ◆ Complete other duties as assigned by the Program Director.
- ◆ Meet with the Program Director before leaving camp for an exit interview.
