Duties and Responsibilities:

- ♦ Read all materials sent before camp.
- ♦ Attend staff orientation.
- ♦ Interact and build relationships with campers.
- ♦ Be a positive role model to campers and other staff.
- ♦ Lead devotional, sharing and prayer times with campers each day.
- Walk in prayer and continue personal spiritual development.
- Assist in maintaining an environment that is presentable and welcoming.
- ♦ Model and support all camp policies and guidelines.
- Participate with campers in all programmed activities and assigned daily tasks
- Complete other duties as assigned by the Summer Camp Manager.
- Meet with the Summer Camp Manager before leaving camp for an exit interview.
