FOOD SERVICE

Food service is offered at the Retreat Lodge, for guests staying in the Upper Level or Upper **and** Lower Levels. Our food service receives high ratings from guests.

- With advance notice, we are able to work with many special dietary needs for a special rate.
- Meals are prepared for a minimum of 16 persons.
- If using food service, a minimum of two meals is required.
- Final meal counts and dietary restrictions are to be reported 2 weeks prior to your arrival. Changes to these counts and restrictions after the 2 week deadline may incur a surcharge.
- You will be charged for the actual number of meals served, or 90% of the reserved number, whichever is greater.
- We do not currently have a full-time Food Service Manager, so meal requests need to be made when you make your reservations. Blackout dates may apply to Food Service.

OTHER MEAL INFORMATION

For those who prefer to prepare their own meals we offer the following options:

RETREAT LODGE, UPPER LEVEL

Meal service is provided (see fee schedule). A refrigerator and microwave in the upper level meeting area may be used for snacks, etc. You will need to provide all serving and eating utensils and there are no facilities available to wash dishes.

Outside catering is an option.

RETREAT LODGE, LOWER LEVEL

The kitchen in the lower level may be used by groups renting the lower level or the entire building. This kitchen is not designed to feed large groups, but is stocked with tableware for approximately 50 persons and some cook/bakeware.

PAVILION

This spacious kitchen is fully stocked and ready for guest groups of up to 150 persons. Enjoy full use of the commercial stove, dishwasher, and other amenities to make large quantity cooking easy!

SHEPHERD'S INN

Designed to accommodate groups of up to 16 persons, this kitchen has been stocked with home amenities including stove, microwave, refrigerator and dishwasher.

ACTIVITY CENTER

Our meeting room has a small kitchenette with sink, microwave and refrigerator and works well as a catering kitchen.

POLICIES AND GUIDELINES



MISSION STATEMENT

Crooked Creek Christian Camp serves the spiritual development of children and adults in the Midwest by providing Christ-centered programs, excellent facilities and generous hospitality in a setting that celebrates God's creation.

GUIDELINES FOR GROUPS

All groups are expected to plan activities and maintain conduct upholding the camp's character.

- DRIVE SLOWLY on Camp grounds! Children or wildlife may be around blind curves.
- Prohibited are: alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, firearms, fireworks, candles, snowmobiles, ATVs, and the use of motor-bikes and horses on foot trails.
- Motor vehicles are to be driven on the gravel lanes only; please keep vehicles off the grass.
- Campfires are permitted only in designated campfire rings.
- Smoking is not permitted in buildings or woods and is discouraged anywhere on the grounds.
- Pets are not permitted in any of the buildings or onsite overnight.
- The pool and waterslide CANNOT be used by guests without prior arrangements with camp staff.
- Food and beverages are not permitted in the cabins.
- Report broken equipment to camp staff.
- Please supervise all children's activities AT ALL TIMES to limit injury and property damage.
- Use of styrofoam products at camp will result in a daily service fee of \$25 unless you carry your trash out with you.

Instructions are posted in each building for clean-up and other general usage. Please abide by all posted instructions and return equipment to the location in which you found it.

FACILITY RESERVATION POLICIES

Our reservation policy allows us to plan for camp activities and maintain a quality experience for persons using our camp. Camp programming takes precedence over guest group reservations. Deposits are nonrefundable except as noted and are subtracted off the total bill at time of payment.

RETREAT LODGE & PAVILION

- Weekend reservations will be taken up to three years in advance with deposit required at that time.
- Groups wishing to come every one, two, or three years must rebook with the comparable date within one week following departure. Same dates in subsequent years are not guaranteed.
- Should guest groups not rebook within that week, the date is open to other groups to reserve.

SHEPHERD'S INN

- Weekend reservations will be taken up to one year in advance with deposit required at that time.
- Groups wishing to come each year must rebook with the comparable date within one week following departure.
- Should guest groups not rebook within that week, the date is open to other groups to reserve.

POOL POLICY

Pool time is divided into 90 minute sessions. Pool times must be scheduled at least 2 weeks prior to your stay.

ACTIVITY CENTER

RESERVATIONS

- Overnight guest groups have priority over outside groups to reserve the Activity Center.
- Weekend guest groups must schedule time at the Activity Center three months prior to their arrival, or the building becomes available for outside groups. If the Activity Center is still available, rental groups may reserve it upon arrival.
- The climbing wall must be scheduled 1 month ahead. *It will not be available upon short notice*.
- The Activity Center is available for reservations between 8 am and 10 pm.
- Camp reserves the right to limit time schedule by any group at the Activity Center.
- The Activity Center is available for scheduling one-year in advance during weekdays.

POLICIES FOR USE General:

• Clean, dry tennis shoes are required inside the building. *Towels are available to dry muddy or wet shoes*.

Climbing Wall:

- A waiver is required for anyone wishing to use the climbing wall
- No bare feet on climbing wall; tennis or climbing shoes are required.
- Climbing wall participants must tie long hair into a pony tail
